

Three Slow-Flight Passes

- <u>High Altitude Pass</u>, 500-1000 AGL: Big picture
 - Wind
 - Runway slope
 - Touchdown point marker
 - Parking area
 - Approach obstructions
 - Departure and climb-out flight path

Three Slow-Flight Passes

- <u>Medium Altitude Pass</u>, 50-100 AGL
 - Wind
 - Runway obstructions
 - Touchdown point
 - Rejected-landing point
 - Wildlife

Three Slow-Flight Passes

- Low Altitude Pass, 5-10 ft AGL:
 - Wind
 - Runway condition
 - Drag a tire?




